²² <u>Do not merely listen to the word</u>, and so deceive yourselves. <u>Do what it says</u>. ²³ Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like someone who looks at his face in a mirror ²⁴ and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like. ²⁵ But whoever looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, AND continues in it—not forgetting what they have heard, but doing it—THEY WILL BE BLESSED IN WHAT THEY DO.
